



ITINERARY KENYA & TZ NC SAFARI 10 DAYS 9 NIGHTS

14TH SEPTEMBER 2015

DAY 1 – 14th Sept 2015: Arrive Nairobi

Arrive at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport Nairobi; you will be met by our Airport representative and transferred to your hotel. Dinner on own.

Overnight at Intercontinental Hotel (BB).

DAY 2 – 15th Sept 2015: Nairobi – Lake Nakuru

After breakfast, you will be briefed about your safari and later drive to Lake Nakuru – colored a shimmering flamingo pink from thousands of the beautiful birds lining its shores. You'll drive through the park and arrive at Lake Nakuru Lodge for lunch and check in. After lunch, proceed on a drive along the shores of the lake – the main spectacles at this lake are the numerous Flamingos, which feed on the abundant algae on the lake. The park also has Kenya's first Rhino Sanctuary and also hosts the rare Rothschild's Giraffe.

After the game-cum-bird viewing, return to the lodge for dinner and

overnight at Lake Nakuru Lodge (FB).

DAY 3 – 16th Sept 2015: Masai Mara Game Reserve

After breakfast, proceed to the world-famous Masai Mara Game Reserve via the Great Rift Valley. En route enjoy the beautiful scenery. Arrive at your Lodge in time for lunch and check in. In the afternoon, enjoy an enthralling game-viewing drive. Spotting lions, cheetahs and other spectacular predators



is the highlight of your day. This evening, enjoy a sumptuous dinner at your Lodge. **Overnight at Mara Keekorok Lodge (FB).**

DAY 4 – 17th Sept 2015: Full day of game viewing

After breakfast, proceed on a full-day game-viewing drive to search for the myriad species of game that make this reserve their home. If you are lucky, you can witness a kill in action, moment-by-moment, right in front of your unbelieving eyes! After a sumptuous lunch at your Lodge, proceed for another exciting game drive, where you can expect to see the famous 'Big 5'. In the evening, enjoy a delicious dinner at your Lodge. **Overnight at Mara Keekorok Lodge (FB).**

DAY 5 - 18th Sept 2015: Transfer to Isebania border (for proceeding to Tanzania Safari)

After breakfast, pick packed lunch boxes and later drive to Isebania. After clearing immigrations, you will exchange vehicles and later drive to Serengeti National Park. Enjoy an en-route game drive in this enormous park, which supports every variety of animals imaginable - from large predators such as lion, leopard and cheetah to the smaller herbivores they prey on. Afternoon game drive, followed by dinner and **overnight at Serengeti Sopa Lodge (FB).**





DAY 6 – 19th Sept 2015: Serengeti

Today you spend the whole day on game drive in this National Park, which is rich with all different species of animals. To maximize game viewing you will carry a picnic lunch with you and spend full day in the Serengeti National Park. **Dinner and overnight at Serengeti Sopa Lodge (FB).**

DAY 7 – 20th Sept 2015: Serengeti – Ngorongoro

After breakfast, drive to Ngorongoro where you arrive in time for lunch, the rest of the afternoon is spent at leisure. **Dinner and overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge (FB).**



DAY 8 – 21st Sept 2015: Ngorongoro

After breakfast, drive to Ngorongoro Crater with packed lunch. The Crater is one of the largest intact volcanic caldera in the world, offering fabulous game viewing and is one of the only such places in Africa. Large grazing animals such as wildebeest, buffalo, gazelle and zebra that depend on the open grasslands are in the crater, attracting predators like, the black-manned lion, the leopard and hyena. The elephants found are lone males. A soda lake attracts water birds, including flamingos and is a suitable place for predators to make their kill. Wildly beautiful as it is, it is not surprising that Ngorongoro Crater has been called a Garden of Eden. **Dinner and overnight at Ngorongoro Sopa Lodge (FB).**



DAY 9 – 22nd Sept 2015: Ngorongoro – Lake Manyara

Drive to Lake Manyara, a soda lake lying in the Great Rift Valley. Upon arrival check-in and lunch at Lake Manyara Serena. Proceed on afternoon game-drive in Lake Manyara National Park, home to the tree-climbing lions. Apart from the varied types of landscape including jungle, swamp and savannah, there are also a large variety of animals including Giraffe, Zebra, Elephant, Gazelle, hippos, monkeys and about 400 different species of birds.

Dinner and overnight at Lake Manyara Serena (FB).



DAY 10 – 23rd Sept 2015: Depart

After breakfast, you will drive to Arusha for lunch and later transfer to JRO for your onward flight.

Passenger Information



Passengers should bring only soft-sided bags on safaris. All the passengers must have Identification Card/Passport with them for internal flights.

Baggage on internal flights is strictly limited to 15kgs per person (including hand luggage). Any excess baggage will be charged by the airline at check-in. Passengers arriving to Kenya/Tanzania may be asked to present a valid Yellow Fever Vaccination Certificate.
